# **Why Psychology Doesn't Work**

These ball players knew who they were long before the crowd witnessed their record breaking defeat of the Golden State Warriors despite the agony of defeat and setbacks, nonetheless, they stayed their course and their purpose pushed them into victory. These men were born to play basketball.

Mark Twain said it best, “The two most important days of your life is when you’re born and when you find out for what.” Finding the answer to the most important question in life: Who Am I, cannot be answered from the same source. It must be ‘outsourced’ to be discovered. Let me prove it to you: Fish cannot survive very long outside of

water. Water is their source to maintain life. Take them from their life source; it's just a matter of time, they will die. It is inevitable. What is my purpose for living? Their talent will not be enough.

Without discovery, talented people begin to lose 'breathe' in the game of life. Talent alone will not fulfill you and take you the distance in the game of life. This is why famous, wealthy and very talented people take their own lives. This is why multitudes are unable to defeat destructive behaviors, though they are appraised for their talents, nonetheless, they are privately tormented and defeated by depression, loneliness and death.

Talent is like the standard icons and APPS that come on your smart phone. You can shuffle them around and update them, but if your phone is damaged, they are good for nothing, but show. Natural talents have been given to every human being by God since the fall of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. They are standard. And like cellular phone standard APPS, when the phone is damaged, they cannot restore the phone, because the 'purpose' of the phone has been compromised. Purpose is fueled and maintained by preparation. Preparation builds confidence. It is essential to personal growth. When you are not confident in who you are, you will collapse under pressure.
